ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the City of Chicago ("City") is a home rule unit of government by virtue of the provisions of the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970, and, as such, may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the City is the owner of the vacant parcel of property located at 1346 South Pulaski Road, Chicago, Illinois 60623, which is legally described on Exhibit A attached hereto (the "Property"); and

WHEREAS pursuant to ordinances adopted by the City Council of the City of Chicago ("City Council") on May 17, 2000, and published at pages 30775 through 30953 in the Journal of Proceedings of the City Council ("Journal") for such date, the City Council approved a certain redevelopment plan and project for the Midwest Redevelopment Project Area ("TIF Area"); and

WHEREAS, the Property is located in the TIF Area; and;

WHEREAS, Redeemed Tabernacle Church of God in Christ ("Grantee"), with a business address of 1340-44 South Pulaski Road, Chicago, Illinois 60623, has offered to purchase the Property from the City for the sum of Three Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$3,000.00), such amount being the appraised fair market value of the Property with a "parking in perpetuity" deed restriction; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 17-010-21 adopted on February 16, 2017, by the Plan Commission of the City ("Commission"), the Commission approved the negotiated sale of the Property to the Grantee: and

WHEREAS, public notices advertising the City's intent to enter into a negotiated sale of the Property with the Grantee and requesting alternative proposals appeared in the Chicago Sun-Times, a newspaper of general circulation, on January 12 and January 19, 2017; and

WHEREAS, no alternative proposals were received by the deadline indicated in the aforesaid notices; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City hereby approves the sale of the Property to the Grantee for the amount of Three Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$3,000.00),

SECTION 2. The Mayor or his proxy is authorized to execute, and the City Clerk or the Deputy City Clerk is authorized to attest, a quitclaim deed conveying the Property to the Grantee. Such deed shall contain language in substantially the following form:

This conveyance is subject to the express conditions that: (1) the Property is improved with a parking lot within twelve (12) months of the date of this deed, and (2) the Property is thereafter maintained and used as a parking lot in perpetuity.

In the event that the foregoing conditions are not met, the City of Chicago may re-enter the Property and revest title in the City of Chicago. Grantee, at the request of the City of Chicago, covenants to execute and deliver to the City a reconveyance deed to the Property to further evidence such revesting

of title. This right of reverter and re-entry in

favor of the City shall terminate forty (40) years from the date of this deed.

The Property is located in the Midwest Redevelopment Project Area established pursuant to ordinances adopted by the City Council on May 17, 2000, and published at pages 30775 through 30953 in the Journal of Proceedings of the City Council for such date. Grantee is obligated to use the Property only for uses permitted under the redevelopment plan for the Area, as now or hereafter amended, until such redevelopment plan expires. Grantee's acceptance of this deed shall be deemed to be Grantee's agreement to comply with such use restrictions.

Grantee acknowledges that if Grantee (or its successors or assigns) develops the Property with a "residential housing project," as that term is defined in Section 2-45-115 of the Municipal Code of the City (the "Affordable Requirements Ordinance"), Grantee (or its successors or assigns) shall be obligated to comply with the Affordable Requirements Ordinance.

Grantee acknowledges and agrees that the Property is being conveyed, and Grantee accepts the Property, in its "as is," "where is" and "with all faults" condition without any covenant, representation or warranty, express or implied, of any kind, as to the structural, physical or environmental condition of the Property or the suitability of the Property for any purpose whatsoever. Grantee, on behalf of herself/himself/themselves/itself (as applicable) and hers/his/their/its (as applicable) successors and assigns, shall release, relinquish and forever discharge Grantor and its officers, employees, agencies, departments and officials, from and against any and all claims, causes of action, demands, legal or administrative proceedings, losses, damages, liabilities, judgments, amounts paid in settlement, interest, fines, penalties, costs and expenses (including, without limitation, reasonable attorney's fees and expenses and court costs) based upon, arising out of or in any way connected with, directly or indirectly, the structural, physical or environmental condition of the Property. The foregoing covenant of release is part of the consideration for the Property and shall run with the land and bind Grantee and Grantee's successors and assigns.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such provision shall not affect any of the other provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
