SINGLE DIRECTION

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 64, Section 010 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the operator of a vehicle shall operate such vehicle only in the Direction Specified below on the public ways between the limits indicated:

WARD SINGLE DIRECTION:

19 South Church Street; South Church Street from South Ashland Avenue to West 109th Place; Single Direction - Southerly [02016-8190]

WARD AMEND SINGLE DIRECTION:

42 North McClurg Court; Repeal Ordinance Passed 07/07/1999, journal page 6940, which reads: North McClurg Court from East Ohio Street to East Ontario Street; Single Direction - Northerly, by Striking the above - (16-07178160) [02016-7144]
