SUBSTITUTE ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Chapter 4-151 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by adding the language underscored and deleting the language stricken through as follows:

4-151-040 Qualifications for licenses.

No license shall be issued under this chapter if the applicant, the manager, range master, or any employee:

- a) Is under 21 years of age;
- b) Has ever been convicted of a felony;

c) Has ever been convicted of a misdemeanor involving a firearm, or any other violation of law concerning the manufacture, use, possession or sale of firearms;

d) Does not possess a valid FOID card; provided that if the applicant is not a natural person, no FOID card shall be required of the applicant or a controlling person;

e) Has within the previous five years submitted false or misleading information in connection with any application for a license relating to the sale or possession of firearms.

It shall also be a prerequisite to the issuance of a license that the manager, range master, and every employee possess a valid FOID card.

4-151-090 Hours of operations.

Shooting range facilities may operate only between the hours of 9 a.m. and 8 p.m. No person shall ope

rate, or permit the operation, of a shooting range facility during any other time.

4-151-100 Standards of operation.

(d) No person under the age of 18 shall be permitted in the shooting range facility unless accompanied by and under the direct supervision of a parent, guardian, or an instructor in a firearms safety and training course recognized by a law enforcement agency, a national or international shooting sports organization, a certified firearms instructor approved by the Illinois State Police or Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board, or a certified firearms and hunter safety instructor approved by the Illinois Department of Wildlife. The licensee shall require every shooting range patron to provide a driver's license or other government-issued identification showing the person's name, date of birth, and photograph.

17-9-0120 Shooting ranges. Shooting ranges may not be located in any of the following areas or I ocations:

17-9-0120 A within 100 feet of another existing shooting range;

■17-9-0101-B within 500 feet of any zoning district that is zoned for residential use, including a planned devolopmont that authorizes residential uso;

17-9-0101-C within 500 feet of any pre-existing school, day care facility, place of worship, premises licensed for the retail sale of liquor, children's activities facility, library, museum or hospital.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is not an expression of policy. Its purpose is to conform the Municipal Code to binding judicial precedent.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect following due passage and approval.
