### WEIGHT LIMITATIONS

#### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

**SECTION 1. Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 72, Section 030 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Maximum Weight Permitted to be carried by any truck or commercial vehicle upon the following public ways between the limits indicated except for the purpose of delivering or picking up material or merchandise shall be as follows:**

WARD	WEIGHT LIMITATIONS:
15	4700-4900 South Seeley Avenue; Weight Limitations - 5 Tons [O2017-3175]
18	West 77th Street; West 77th Street from South Kedzie Avenue to South Columbus Avenue; Weight Limitations 5 - Tons [O2017-280]

**SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force here in after its passage and publication. CHICAGO, APRIL 19, 2017**

To the President and Members of the City Council:
