SECTION 1. That the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to establish and/or amend Two Hour Parking Restriction Signs at the below listed locations:

23 West 63rd Place; West 63rd Place (north side) from a point 20 feet west of South St. Louis Avenue to a point 105 feet West thereof; Two Hour Parking, All Times, All Days, Public Benefit [02017-5297]
