### LOADING ZONES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 64, Section 160, of the Municipal Code of . Chicago, the following locations are hereby designated as Loading Zones for the distances specified, during the hours specified:

#### WARD LOADING ZONES / STANDING ZONES:

25 West 18th Place; West 18th Place (north side) from a point 20 feet west of South Paulina Street to a point 155 feet west thereof; 30 Minutes Standing Zone, Use Flashing Lights, 7:00am to 6:00pm, Monday through Friday, Public Benefit --(16-04934321) [02016-5422]

#### WARD AMEND LOADING ZONES / STANDING ZONES:

30 North Karlov Avenue; Repeal Ordinance Passed 06/25/2014, journal page 83698, which reads: North Karlov Avenue (west side) from North Milwaukee Avenue to the first alley south thereof; 30 Minute Standing Zone, Use Flashing Lights, 10:00am to 7:00pm, Tuesday through Thursday and 9:00am to 8:00pm, Friday through Saturday, by Striking the above - (17-04708244) [02017-3771]

43 938 West Webster Avenue; Amend Ordinance which reads: 938 West Webster Avenue; No Parking Loading Zone, 5:00pm to 1:00pm, Thursday, Friday and Saturday, by Striking: 5:00pm to 1:00pm, and Inserting: 8:00am to 1:00am, All Days in lieu thereof - (17-00613332) [02016-7750]
