Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to UNIVERSITY OF CHICAGO, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, six (6) Earth Retention System(s) under the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 5620-40 S. Drexel Ave..

Said Earth Retention System(s) at Alley East of Drexel Ave measure(s)¹

Two (2) at sixteen (16) feet in length, and one point one seven (1.17) foot in width for a total of thirty-seven point four four (37.44) square feet. Existing earth retention system is approximately thirty-two (32) feet below grade level.

Said Earth Retention System(s) at S. Drexel Ave measure(s):

Two (2) at seventy-six (76) feet in length, and one point one seven (1.17) foot in width for a total of one hundred seventyseven point eight four (177.84) square feet. Existing earth retention system is approximately thirty-two (32) feet below grade level.

Said Earth Retention System(s) at Alley West of Drexel Ave measure(s):

Two (2) at sixteen (16) feet in length, and one point one seven (1.17) foot in width for a total of thirty-seven point four four (37.44) square feet. Existing earth retention system is approximately thirty-two (32) feet below grade level.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Office of Underground Coordination).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1129772 herein granted the sum of four

hundred (\$400.00) per annum in advance.
