ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing all of the RT4 Residential Two-Flat, Townhouse and Multi-Unit District symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 6-1

West 24th Street; a perpendicular line to South Sacramento Avenue 31 feet South of and parallel to West 24th street; and the public alley perpendicular to West 24th Street next west of and parallel to South Sacramento Avenue

to those of a Bl-1 Neighborhood Shopping District

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and due publication.
