TWO HOUR PARKING

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. That the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to establish and/or amend Two Hour Parking Restriction Signs at the below listed locations:

WARD MISCELLANEOUS:

- 10 East 97th Street; Amend Ordinance which reads: East 97th Street from South Commercial Avenue (south side) east to alley; Two Hour Parking, by Striking: Two Hour Parking and Inserting: Monday through Saturday, 9:00am to 6:00pm in lieu thereof [02017-7650]
- 10 East 97th Street; Amend Ordinance which reads: East 97th Street from the alley west of South Commercial Avenue to South Commercial Avenue (south side); Two Hour Parking, by Striking: Two Hour Parking and Inserting: Monday through Saturday, 9:00am to 6:00pm in lieu thereof [02017-7651]

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force here in after its passage and publication.
