ORDINANCE The University of Chicago Acct. No. 43697- 107

Permit No. 1129764

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to The University of Chicago, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, two (2) Sheeting(s) under the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 5757 S. University Ave..

Said Sheeting(s) at E. 58th Street measure(s):

One (1) at two hundred sixty point two five (260.25) feet in length, and two point five (2.5) feet in width for a total of six hundred fifty point six three (650.63) square feet. Existing sheeting is approximately seven point (7.5) feet below grade level

Said Sheeting(s) at S. Woodlawn Avenue measure(s):

One (1) at ninety-eight point nine two (98.92) feet in length, and two point zero eight (2.08) feet in width for a total of two hundred five point seven five (205.75) square feet. Existing sheeting is approximately seven point five (7.5) feet below grade level.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Planning and Development and Department of Transportation (Office of Underground Coordination).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1129764 herein granted the sum of eight hundred (\$800.00) per annum in advance.

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A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.
