### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

**SECTION 1. That the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to establish and/or amend No Parking During Stadium Events Signs at the below listed locations:**

### WARD MISCELLEANEOUS:

50 6400 and 6500 North Troy Street; 6400 and 6500 North Troy Street (east and west sides) from West Devon Avenue to West Albion Avenue, 6400-6499 and 6500-6599 North Kedzie Avenue (east side) from West Devon Avenue to West Albion Avenue, and 3114-3199 West Arthur Avenue from North Kedzie Avenue to the first alley east of North Troy Street, No Parking During Stadium Events, except residents displaying permits - (17-08204613) [02017-5578]
