LOADING ZONES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 64, Section 160, of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the following locations are hereby designated as Loading Zones for the distances specified, during the hours specified:

- WARD LOADING ZONES/STANDING ZONES:**
- 1 1714 West Division Street; 1714 West Division Street (north side) from a point 22 feet west of North Paulina Avenue to a point 40 feet west thereof; 30 Minute Standing Zone, Use Flashing Lights, Tow Zone after 30 Minutes, 11:00am to 11:00pm, All Days -- (17-07150803) [02017-7322]
 - 30 2800 North Mason Avenue; 2800 North Mason Avenue (west side) from a point 30 feet north of West Diversey Avenue to a point 90 feet north thereof; 15 Minute Standing Zone, Use Flashing Lights, All Times, All Days, Public Benefit - (17-07747857) [02017-8407]
 - 34 West 111 th Street; West 111 th Street (north side) from a point 260 feet west of South Perry Avenue to a point 40 feet west thereof; Disabled Loading Zone, All Times, All Days, Public Benefit - (17-07155766) [02017-7149]

- WARD AMEND LOADING ZONES / STANDING ZONES :**
- 35 2700 North Sawyer Avenue; Amend Ordinance Passed 04/13/2016, journal page 22603, which reads: North Sawyer Avenue (west side) from a point 30 feet east of North Milwaukee Avenue to a point 40 feet east thereof; 15 minute Standing Zone, Use Flashing Lights, Tow Zone after 15

minutes, 9:00am to 5:00pm, Monday through Friday, Public Benefit, by Striking: to a point 40 feet and Inserting: to a point 80 feet in lieu thereof - (17-06168474) [02017-6332]

- 44 West Barry Avenue; Amend Ordinance Passed 05/26/2004 journal page 24921, which reads; West Barry Avenue (south side) from a point 235 feet east of North Broadway to a point 25 feet east thereof; 15 Minute Standing Zone, Unattended Vehicles must Use Flashing Lights, Tow Away Zone after 15 Minutes, 7:00am to 7:00pm by Striking: 7:00pm and Inserting: 12:00am in lieu thereof-- (17-08546104) [02017-8637]

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force here in after its passage and publication.


