#### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing all of the CI-1 Neighborhood Commercial District symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 7-1 in an area bound by

A line 25 feet East of North Maplewood Avenue; the alley next North of and parallel to West Fullerton Avenue; a line 49 feet East of North Maplewood and West Fullerton Avenue."
