ORDINANCE THE BLANCHARD
Acct. No. 395450 -1 Permit No.
1132635

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to THE BLANCHARD upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance, to maintain and use a portion of the public right of way for a sidewalk cafe adjacent to its premises located at 1935 N. Lincoln Park West. Said sidewalk cafe area #1 shall be twenty-two (22) feet in length and ten point one seven (10.17) feet in width, area #2 shall be seventy-nine point two five (79.25) feet in length and ten point one seven (10.17) feet in width for a total of one thousand twenty-nine point seven one (1029.71) square feet and shall allow six (6) feet of clear space from the face of the curb/building line along North Lincoln Park West and North Clark. The compensation for said space and the days and hours of operation for the sidewalk cafe shall be as follows:

Tuesday through Thursday 5:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. Friday 5:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. Saturday and Sunday 10:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. Compensation: \$1,853.48 SEATING CAPACITY: 61

Sidewalk Cafe Permit and approved plan must be posted at all times.

This grant of privilege #1132635 for a sidewalk cafe shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-800 though 10-28-885 of the Municipal Code of Chicago and the directions of the Commissioner of Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection, the Commissioner of Streets and Sanitation, and the Commissioner of Transportation.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.
