SECTION 1. That the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to establish and/or amend Two Hour Parking at the below listed locations:

- WARD MISCELLEANEOUS:
- 15 South Fairfield Avenue (east side) from West 47th Street to a point 115 feet north thereof; Two Hour Parking Sign, 6:00am to 10:00pm, All Days [02018-3876]
- 23 South Neva Avenue (east and west sides) from West Archer Avenue to the first alley south thereof; Two Hour Parking, 8:00am to 6:00pm, Monday through Saturday, Public Benefit [02018-3302]
- 27 410 North Carpenter Street (west side) from a point 20 feet north of North Kinzie Street to a point 30 feet north thereof; Two Hour Parking, 8:00am to 5:00pm, Monday through Saturday. Not Recommended - (17-04639575) [02017-4296] '!
