#### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing all of the B3-1 Community Shopping District Symbols on Map No. 9-0 in the area bounded by

West Addison Street; A line 35 feet east of and parallel to North Osceola Avenue; the public alley south of and parallel to West Addison Street; North Osceola Avenue;

to those of B2-2 Neighborhood Mixed-Use District

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and due publication.
