45	North Northwest Highway; Amend Industrial Permit Parking Zone 54, 6:00am to 3:00pm, Monday through Friday, by Striking: 6:00am to 6:00pm and Inserting: 6:00am to 3:00pm in lieu thereof [02018-5911]
