SECTION 1. That the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to establish and/or amend No Parking Except School/Police Personnel Signs at the below listed locations:

### WARD MISCELLENEOUS:

- 12 South Sacramento Avenue (west side) from West Pershing Road to West 39th Place and Also South Albany Street (east side) from West Pershing Road to West 39th Place; No Parking School Personnel Permit Parking Only, 7:30am through 4:00pm, School Days - (18-01731471) [02018-4185]
- 28 South Leavitt Street (east side) from West Harrison Street to West Flournoy Street; Police Parking Personnel Only, All Times, All Days - (18-02671030) [02018-7564]
