ORDINANCE COLUMBIA
COLLEGE Acct. No. 85612-5
Permit No. 1136301

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to COLUMBIA COLLEGE, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, , one (1) black iron Pipe projecting over the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 731 S. Plymouth Ct.. Existing black iron pipe located in the public alley is used for ventilation purposes, affixed to the east side of the building starting at a height approximately twenty (20) feet above the public way, proceeding to the roof area and measuring approximately two (2) feet by two (2) feet.

Said Pipe(s) at Public Alley measure(s):
One (1) at two (2) feet in length, and one point six seven (1.67) foot in width for a total of three point three four (3.34) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Office of Underground Coordination) and Department of Water Management.

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.


The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1136301 herein granted the sum of four hundred (\$400.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs

associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way
