SUBSTITUTE ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Section 9-64-110 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by deleting the struck-through language and inserting the underscored language, as follows:

9-64-110 Parking prohibited - Roadways, sidewalks, bridges and similar locations.

It shall be unlawful to stand or park any vehicle in any of the following places:

(Omitted text not affected by this ordinance)

(e) On a parkway, except in case of an emergency, and except in the following locations: or as provided in section 9-64-113;

ar the parkway curb and carriage walk located on West Juneway Terrace (north side) from 1416 to 1546 and (south side) from 1415 to 1547, marked with signs indicating "parking permitted on curb and carriage walk";

(Omitted text not affected by this ordinance)

SECTION 2. Chapter 9-64 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by inserting a new section 9-64-113, as follows:

9-64-113 Parking prohibited on a parkway - exceptions.

Vehicles may park with two wheels on a parkway curb or carriage walk in the following locations, which shall be identified by signs indicating that such parking is allowed:

- (a) West Juneway Terrace (north side) from 1416 to 1546 and (south side) from 1415 to 1547
- (b) North Lawler Avenue (west side) from 4014 to 4142 and (east side) from 4019 to 4141

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon passage and publication.
