BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. That the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to establish and/or amend Reserved Parking (2%Disabled) Signs at the below listed locations:

WARD MISCELLEANEOUS:

40 5712 North Talman Avenue(west side) from a point 120 feet north of West Hollywood

Avenue to a point 25 f feet north thereof; Reserved Parking (2%Disabled), All Times, All Days, Public

Benefit - (19-00015396) [02018-9432]

49 2045 West Jarvis Avenue (south side) from a point 120 feet west of North Seeley

Avenue to a point 25 feet west thereof; Reserved Parking (2% Disabled), All Times, All Days, Public

Benefit - (19-00019153) [02018-9433]

49 1727 West North Shore Avenue (south side) from a point 59 feet east of North

Hermitage Avenue to a point 25 feet east thereof; Reserved Parking (2% Disabled), All Times, All Days,
