ORDINANCE

The Wicker Park & Bucktown Chamber of Commerce Acct. No.

219573-43 Permit No. 1129984

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to The Wicker Park & Bucktown Chamber of Commerce, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, one (1) Trash container(s) on the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 1400 N. Milwaukee Ave..

Said Trash container(s) at N. Milwaukee Avenue measure(s):

One (1) at one point eight eight (1.88) foot in length, and one point nine seven (1.97) foot in width for a total of three point seven (3.7) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.


Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1129984 herein granted the sum of seventy-five (\$75.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date. Page 1

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.



The applicant referenced above has requested the use of the public right-of-way for a trash container(s).
