ORDINANCE WOLCOTT TAP Acct. No. 412281 -1 Permit No. 1138713

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to WOLCOTT TAP upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance, to maintain and use a portion of the public right of way for a sidewalk cafe adjacent to its premises located at 1834 W. Montrose Ave.. Said sidewalk cafe area #1 shall be sixty (60) feet in length and eleven point nine two (11.92) feet in width for a total of seven hundred fifteen point two (715.2) square feet and shall allow six (6) feet of clear space from the face of the curb/building line along N. Wolcott Avenue. The compensation for said space and the days and hours of operation for the sidewalk cafe shall be as follows:

Monday and Tuesday 4:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. Wednesday and Thursday 11:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. Friday and Saturday 11:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. Sunday 11:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.

Compensation: \$786.72 SEATING

CAPACITY: 72

Sidewalk Cafe Permit and approved plan must be posted at all times.

This grant of privilege #1138713 for a sidewalk cafe shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-800 though 10-28-885 of the Municipal Code of Chicago and the directions of the Commissioner of Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection, the Commissioner of Streets and Sanitation, and the Commissioner of Transportation.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.
