ORDINANCE LIZZIE MC NEILLS Acct. No. 14172-1 Permit No. 1138647

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to LIZZIE MC NEILLS upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance, to maintain and use a portion of the public right of way for a sidewalk cafe adjacent to its premises located at 400 N. Mcclurg CL. Said sidewalk cafe area #1 shall be seventy-two (72) feet in length and four point five (4.5) feet in width, area #2 shall be <a href="http://shall.be">http://shall.be</a> eighteen (18) feet in length and four point five (4.5) feet in width, area #3 shall be one (1) feet in length and one (1) feet in width for a total of four hundred six (406) square feet and shall allow six (6) feet of clear space from the face of the curb/building line along 400 N McClurg Court, New St., 401 N McClurg Crt/E. River Dr.. The compensation for said space and the days and hours of operation for the sidewalk cafe shall be as follows:

Sunday through Saturday 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 midnight Compensation: \$933.80 SEATING CAPACITY: 180

Sidewalk Cafe Permit and approved plan must be posted at all times.

This grant of privilege #1138647 for a sidewalk cafe shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-800 though 10-28-885 of the Municipal Code of Chicago and the directions of the Commissioner of Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection, the Commissioner of Streets and Sanitation, and the Commissioner of Transportation.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.
