Whereas, On the afternoon of Sunday, January 27th, 2019, Chicago Police Officers rescued a man and his dog from the icy waters of Lake Michigan. This resolution honors those efforts; and

WHEREAS, This incident began when a man was walking his dog along Foster Beach. The individual had recently acquired a nine-month-old American Eskimo mix breed named Pika and was taking it for its first walk to the beach; and

WHEREAS, At some point during the walk, the man let his dog off its leash. The dog immediately bolted for the beach, where six to eight foot-high ice ridges had formed as a result of the very cold temperatures; and

WHEREAS, Pika reached the top of the ridge but lost its footing and plunged into the frigid waters of Lake Michigan; and

WHEREAS, In an effort to rescue his dog, the owner raced to the ice ridge and jumped into the freezing water, which was waist deep; and

WHEREAS, The owner put the nineteen-pound dog on his shoulders and tried to climb up the sheer ice wall but was unable to do so; and

WHEREAS, Realizing after several tries that he couldn't extricate himself from the freezing water, and having lost virtually all sensation in his hands, the man barely managed to call 9-1-1; and

WHEREAS, At the same time, a passerby who was walking her dog had seen the man jump into the water so she alerted nearby police officers; and

WHEREAS, One of these officers radioed for Chicago Police Department and Fire Department assistance. Multiple units responded. The officers on the scene formed a human chain to attempt rescue.
