BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 64, of the Municipal Code of Chicago, that the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to erect and/or amend Traffic Warning Signs and Signals, for the following locations are hereby designated:

WARD TRAFFIC WARNING SIGNS AND/OR SIGNALS:

5 East 69th Street and South Cornell Avenue; All Way Stop Sign, Stopping All Approaches [02019-2649]

South Ellis Avenue and East 82nd Street; All-Way Stop Sign, Stopping All Approaches - (18-02810215) [Or2018-475]

South Rockwell Avenue and West Cullerton Street; All Way Stop Sign, Stopping All Approaches [02018-4188]

South Campbell Avenue and West 39th Place; Stop Sign, Stopping South Campbell Avenue for West 39th Place [O2017-6768]

South Throop Street and West 114th Place; All Way Stop Sign, Stopping All Approaches - (18-03172349) [Or2018-581]

South Sangamon Street and West 104th Street; All-Way Stop Sign, Stopping All Approaches - (18-03172370) [Or2018-582]

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force here in after its passage and publication.
