Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to ROOSEVELT COLLECTION SHOPS, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, two (2) Canopy(s) projecting over the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 150 W. Roosevelt Rd..

Said Canopy(s) at S. Wells measure(s):

One (1) at thirty-nine point two five (39.25) feet in length, and three point one seven (3.17) feet in width for a total of one hundred twenty-four point four two (124.42) square feet.

One (1) at fifteen (15) feet in length, and three point nine (3.9) feet in width for a total of fifty-eight point five (58.5) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Zoning Department - Signs.

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1141303 herein granted the sum of one hundred fourteen dollars and twenty-five cents (\$114.25) per annum in advance.
