#### **ORDINANCE**

LAKE PARK ASSOCIATES Acct. No. 379530 - 19 Permit No. 1124950

Se It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to LAKE PARK ASSOCIATES, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, two (2) Building Projection(s) projecting over the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 5238 S. Harper Ave..

Said Building Projection(s) at S Harper Ave Lower Band of Terra Cotta measure(s):

One (1) at sixty-three point nine two (63.92) feet in length, and point eight three (.83) feet in width for a total of fifty-three point zero five (53.05) square feet.

Said Building Projection(s) at S Harper Ave Upper Band of Terra Cotta measure(s):

One (1) at sixty-four (64) feet in length, and two (2) feet in width for a total of one hundred twenty-eight (128) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Planning and Development and Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1124950 herein granted the sum of zero (\$.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after 1/1/02/2016
