#### **ORDINANCE**

ROOSEVELT COLLECTION SHOPS Acct. No.

456869 - 1 Permit No. 1141301

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to ROOSEVELT COLLECTION SHOPS, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, eighteen (18) Balcony(s) projecting over the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 150 W. Roosevelt Rd..

Said Balcony(s) at W. Roosevelt Road measure(s)<sup>1</sup>

Six (6) at sixteen point five eight (16.58) feet in length, and one point five eight (1.58) foot in width for a total of one hundred fifty-seven point one eight (157.18) square feet.

Six (6) at nine point zero eight (9.08) feet in length, and one point five (1.5) foot in width for a total of eighty-one point seven two (81.72) square feet.

Six (6) at fourteen point five (14.5) feet in length, and one point five (1.5) foot in width for a total of one hundred thirty point five (130.5) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Planning and Development and Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1141301 herein granted the sum of one thousand three hundred fifty (\$1,356.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way. Page 1
