ORDINANCE 43RD FOOD &  
MORE Acct. No. 378135-1 Permit  
No. 1142969

*Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:*

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to 43RD FOOD & MORE, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to construct, install, maintain and use two (2) Door Swing(s) projecting over the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 246 W. 43rd St..

Said Door Swing(s) at W 43rd St measure(s):  
Two (2) at three (3) feet in length, and six (6) feet in width for a total of thirty-six (36) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1142969 herein granted the sum of one hundred fifty (\$150.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.
