BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

LOADING ZONES / STANDING ZONES:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 64, Section 160, of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the following locations are hereby designated as Loading Zones for the distances specified, during the hours specified:

42	West Erie Street (south side) from a point 30 feet west of North Sedgwick - Street to a point 20 feet west thereof; 15 Minute Standing Zone, All Times, All Days - (19-01915520) (Public Benefit) [02019-7155]
45	North Milwaukee Avenue; Repeal Ordinance which reads: North Milwaukee Avenue (east side) form a point 135 feet west of North Laramie Avenue to a point 35 feet west thereof; No Parking Loading Zone, 8:00am-4:00pm, Monday through Saturday, by Striking the above(19-
