#### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

**SECTION 1. That the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to establish and/or amend Speed Limitations at the below listed locations:**

#### WARD MISCELLEANEOUS:

- 10 South Torrence Avenue from East 106<sup>th</sup> Street to East 130<sup>th</sup> Street, Amend Ordinance passed 6/16/1994, On Journal page 52082; Speed Limitations, which reads: South Torrence Avenue from East 106<sup>th</sup> Street to East 130<sup>th</sup> Street 40 Miles Per Hour, by Striking 40 Miles Per Hour, and inserting 30 Miles Per Hour in lieu thereof; [O2020-2]
- 10 South Torrence Avenue from East 106<sup>th</sup> Street to East 110<sup>th</sup> Street, Amend Ordinance passed 6/16/1994, On Journal page 52082; Speed Limitations, which reads: South Torrence Avenue from East 106<sup>th</sup> Street to East 110<sup>th</sup> Street, 35 Miles Per Hour, by Striking 35 Miles Per Hour, and inserting 30 Miles Per Hour in lieu thereof; [O2020-3]
