TRAFFIC WARNING SIGN AND/OR SIGNALS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 64, of the Municipal Code of Chicago, that the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to erect and/or amend Traffic Warning Signs and Signals, for the following locations are hereby designated:

WARD TRAFFIC WARNING SIGNS AND/OR SIGNALS:

- 39 North Ridgeway Avenue and West Granville Avenue; Stop Sign [O2020-1636]
- 39 West Berwyn Avenue and North Bernard Street; All Way Stop Sign [O2020-1806]
- 45 North Lockwood Avenue and West Byron Street; Three-Way Stop Sign, Stopping westbound and southbound traffic at West Byron Street [O2020-94]
