West Montrose Avenue (east side) from a point 20 feet east of North Greenview Avenue to a point 65 feet east thereof; Two Hour Parking, 9:00am to 10:00pm, Monday through

Saturday, by Striking the above [02019-585] TIME RESTRICTION. NOT

RECOMMENDED."
