ORDINANCE
PUBLICAN QUALITY MEATS Acct. No. 362776 - 1
Permit No. 1144508

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to PUBLICAN QUALITY MEATS upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance, to maintain and use a portion of the public right of way for a sidewalk cafe adjacent to its premises located at 825 W. Fulton Market. Said sidewalk cafe area #1 shall be thirty-eight point six seven (38.67) feet in length and seven point zero eight (7.08) feet in width, area #2 shall be twenty-three point six seven (23.67) feet in length and seven point zero eight (7.08) feet in width, area #3 shall be twenty-two point three four (22.34) feet in length and eleven (11) feet in width for a total of six hundred eighty-seven point one one (687.11) square feet and shall allow six (6) feet of clear space from the face of the curb/building line along N. Green Street, W. Fulton Market. The compensation for said space and the days and hours of operation for the sidewalk cafe shall be as follows:

Monday through Sunday 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 midnight. Compensation:
\$755.82 SEATING CAPACITY: 60

Sidewalk Cafe Permit and approved plan must be posted at all times.

This grant of privilege #1144508 for a sidewalk cafe shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-800 through 10-28-885 of the Municipal Code of Chicago and the directions of the Commissioner of Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection, the Commissioner of Streets and Sanitation, and the Commissioner of Transportation.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way..
