SECTION 2. Section 4-60-023 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by replacing subsection 4-60-023 (50.74), which was previously deleted as shown in the Journal of Proceedings of July 24, 2019 at page 2664, with the following underscored text:

4-60-023 Restrictions on Additional Package Goods Licenses.

Subject to the provisions of subsection 4-60-021 (c), no additional package goods license shall be issued for any premises located within the following areas:
