TRAFFIC WARNING SIGN AND/OR SIGNALS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 64, of the Municipal Code of Chicago, that the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to erect and/or amend Traffic Warning Signs and Signals, for the following locations are hereby designated:

WARD TRAFFIC WARNING SIGNS AND/OR SIGNALS:

- 11 West 37th Street (east leg) and South Morgan Street; All Way Stop, Stopping All Approaches [02020-2566]
- 11 West 25th Place and South Morgan Street; All Way Stop, Stopping All Approaches [02020-2569]
- 35 North Hamlin Avenue and West Windsor Avenue; All Way Stop, Stopping Approaches [Or2020-146]

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force here in after its passage and CHICAGO, JUNE 17, 2020

To the President and Members of the City Council:
