SECTION 1. Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 64, of the Municipal Code of Chicago, that the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to erect and/or amend Traffic Warning Signs and Signals, for the following locations are hereby designated:

WARD	TRAFFIC WARNING SIGNS AND/OR SIGNALS:
11	West 37th Street (east leg) and South Morgan Street; All Way Stop, Stopping All Approaches [02020-2566]
11	West 25th Place and South Morgan Street; All Way Stop, Stopping All Approaches [02020-2569]
35	North Hamlin Avenue and West Windsor Avenue; All Way Stop, Stopping Approaches $[\mathrm{Or}2020\text{-}146]$
