SUBSTITUTE ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Section 2-92-490 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by inserting the text underscored, and by deleting the text struck through, as follows:

2-92-490 Duties of the chief procurement officer.

The chief procurement officer shall, in coordination with the board, perform the following duties:

(Omitted text unaffected by this ordinance)

(d) Maintain an electronic directory of certified C.E.B.s and participating established businesses, describing them by name, business address, classification and type of business; and whether the business is located in a qualified investment area, as defined in Section 16-14-020 of the Municipal Code of Chicago. Additionally, in the case of M.B.E.s, such directory shall also include the minority group or minority groups of which the person or persons who own or control the business is a member, or, in the case of a publicly held corporation, the minority group or minority groups of which the person or persons who own at least 51% of the corporation's stock is a member. This directory shall be made available to any interested person. A local business which meets all the requirements to be certified as a C.E.B. under this chapter except for the fact that it has become a non-participating established business since its initial certification may request to be listed in the directory, although it will remain ineligible for participation in the certification program;

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage and publication.
