ORDINANCE

Mansueto Belden-Stratford Acct. No.
461473 - 2 Permit No. 1146315

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to Mansueto Belden-Stratford, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to construct, install, maintain and use four (4) Landscaping(s) on the public right-of-way for beautification purposes adjacent to its premises known as 2300 N. Lincoln Park West.

Said Landscaping(s) at N. Lincoln Park West measure(s):

One (1) at twenty-one point seven five (21.75) feet in length, and nine point five eight (9.58) feet in width for a total of two hundred eight point three seven (208.37) square feet.

Said Landscaping(s) at W. Belden measure(s):

One (1) at twenty-one point four two (21.42) feet in length, and eleven point eight three (11.83) feet in width for a total of two hundred fifty-three point four (253.4) square feet.

One (1) at twenty-one point five eight (21.58) feet in length, and eleven point eight three (11.83) feet in width for a total of two hundred fifty-five point two nine (255.29) square feet.

One (1) at thirty-seven point two five (37.25) feet in length, and eleven point eight three (11.83) feet in width for a total of four hundred forty point six seven (440.67) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Planning and Development and Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1146315 herein granted the sum of zero (\$0.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after Date of Passage.
