# **ORDINANCE**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing all the current C3-3, Commercial, Manufacturing and Employment District symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 4-F in the area bounded by:

the public alley next north of and parallel to West 18<sup>th</sup> Street; the public alley next cast of and parallel to South Clinton Street; West 18<sup>th</sup> Street; and a line 50.00 feet east of and parallel to South Clinton Street

to those of a B2-3, Neighborhood Mixed-Use District.




