ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. The City Council finds that the areas described in Section 2 of this ordinance are adversely affected by the over-concentration of businesses licensed to sell alcoholic liquor within and near the areas.

SECTION 2. Section 4-60-023 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by inserting the underscored language, as follows:

4-60-023 Restrictions on additional package goods licenses.

Subject to the provisions of subsection 4-60-021 (c), no additional package goods license shall be issued for any premises located within the following areas:

(Omitted text is unaffected by this ordinance)

- 68) On Archer Avenue, from Sacramento Avenue to Francisco Avenue.
- 69) On Archer Avenue, from Francisco Avenue to California Avenue.
- 70) On Archer Avenue, from California Avenue to Brighton Place.
- 71) On Archer Avenue, from Brighton Place to 39th Place.
- 72) On Archer Avenue, from 39th Place to Rockwell Street.
