ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

Section 1. Section 9-64-110 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by deleting the struck-through language and inserting the underscored language, as follows:

9-64-110 Parking prohibited - Roadways, sidewalks, bridges and similar locations.

It shall be unlawful to stand or park any vehicle in any of the following places.

Section 2. Chapter 9-64 of Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by inserting a new section 9-64-113, as follows:

9-64-113 Parking prohibited on a parkway - exceptions.

Shall be unlawful to stand or park any vehicle in any of the following places:

(e) On a parkway, except in case of emergency and limited parking (no vehicle storage) on premises:

- the parkway curb located on West Columbus Drive (north side) from 2400 to 2440 and (south side) from 2401 to 3959, marked with signs indicating "parking permitted on curb"
- the parkway curb located on S. Kedzie Avenue (west side) from 8022 to 8026, marked with signs indicating "parking permitted on curb"

Vehicles may park with two wheels on a parkway curb or carriage walk in the following locations, which shall be identified by signs indicating that such parking is allowed:

a) West 83rd Place (north side) from 3514 to 3556 and (south side) 3515 to 3621 SECTION 3. This

ordinance shall be in force and effect upon passage and publication.
