ORDINANCE

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Chapter Municipal 2-92-330 the Code Chicago hereby amended striking language adding language by certain and the underscored, as follows:

2-92-330 Contracts - Percentages of city and project area SEDA residents work hours - Enforcement.

(a-+)- For purposes of this section,

"City residents" means persons domiciled within the city.

"Project area Socio-economically disadvantaged SEDA) area (or residents" domiciled persons within that of means part the city designated **SEDA** in the as an area most recent map generated by the city (EXHIBIT and all subsequent updated maps A superseding it) shqll be included information that as part of the for bidders issued by DPS.

"Domicile" means an individual's one and only true, fixed and permanent home and principal establishment.

"Eligible residents" means city residents and project area SEDA

residents.

For construction project advertised, if not advertised, awarded, by the city that has an estimated contract value \$100,000.00 prohibited and where or more, not otherwise by federal, state or the total hours local law, worked by persons site of the construction project by employees of the contractor and subcontractors shall be performed (i) at least **50** percent residents; and (ii) at least 7.5 percent by project area SEDA city Work residents. hours performed by project area **SEDA** residents shall be considered to be work hours performed by city residents purposes of calculating the minimum work hour percentage required to be performed by city residents.

(Omitted language unaffected by this ordinance)

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect 30 days after passage and publication.
