#### **ORDINANCE**

METROPOLITAN PIER AND EXPOSITION AUTHORITY Acct. No.

2675 - 24 Permit No. 1147772

### Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to METROPOLITAN PIER AND EXPOSITION AUTHORITY, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, two (2) Pedestrian Bridge(s) projecting over the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 200 E. Cermak Rd..

### Said Pedestrian Bridge(s) at E. Cermak Road measure(s):

One (1) at one hundred eighty-eight point eight three (188.83) feet in length, and thirteen point nine two (13.92) feet in width for a total of two thousand six hundred twenty-eight point five one (2628.51) square feet.

#### Said Pedestrian Bridge(s) at S. Prairie Avenue measure(s):

One (1) at one hundred nine point eight three (109.83) feet in length, and thirteen point nine two (13.92) feet in width for a total of one thousand five hundred twenty-eight point eight three (1528.83) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Planning and Development, Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development), and Department of Transportation (Office of Underground Coordination).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1147772 herein granted the sum of zero (\$.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

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The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.
