TRAFFIC LANE - TOW ZONES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 64, of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the following locations are hereby designated as Traffic Lane - Tow Zones, between the limits and during the times specified, standing or parking of any vehicle shall be considered a definite hazard to the normal movement of traffic:

WARD	TOW ZONES:
25	"Recommended To Read: West Taylor Street (north side) from a point 148ft East of South Wells Street to a point 173 ft East thereof: No Parking Monday through Friday 7:00am-5:00am Except for School Personnel Tow Zone [O2021-948]-21-03869596,"
39	West Cullom Avenue (south side) from North Keeler Avenue to North Kildare Avenue next to Belding Elementary School, 7:00am to 4:30pm , Monday -Friday (school days) [02021-1853]
41	North Avondale Avenue (east side) from Devon Avenue North to the first Driveway; No Parking, All Times, All Days [02021-1847]

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force here in after its passage and publication.
