- 7 South Merrill Avenue and East 74th Street; All Way Stop Sign, Stopping All Approaches [02021-1679]
- 7 South Crandon Avenue and East 74th Street; All Way Stop, Stopping All Approaches [02021-1823]
- 13 Recommended To Read South Kilbourn Avenue and W 64th Place All-Way Stop, Stopping All Approaches [Or2021-52] 21-03869434
