LOADING ZONES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 64, Section 160, of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the following locations are hereby designated as Loading Zones for the distances specified, during the hours specified:

WARD LOADING ZONES / STANDING ZONES:

- 4 South Lake Park Avenue (east side) from East 43rd Street To a Point 140 feet north thereof No Parking Loading Zone 4:30pm to 7:00am , All Days (Public Benefit) [02021-2668]
- 27 125 North Damen Avenue, No Parking Loading Zone, Monday through Friday, 7:00am to 9:00pm [02021-2914]
- 27 1109 West Washington Boulevard, No Parking Loading Zone, All Times, All Days [02021-2915]
- "Recommended To Read; West Madison Avenue, North side., From a Point
 105ft. West of North Pulaski Road To a Point 40 feet West thereof; 15 Minute Standing Zone,
 Use Flashing Lights, All Days, All Times [O2021-2078]. 21-04083406"

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force here in after its passage and publication. CHICAGO, JULY 21, 2021
