2% DISABLED PARKING SIGN

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. That the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to establish and/or amend 2% Disabled Parking Signs at the below listed locations:

- WARD 2% DISABLED PARKING SIGN:**
- 1 507 North Paulina Street; Reserved 2% Disabled Parking on North Paulina Street, Eastside, from a point 78 feet North of West Grand Avenue, to a point 20 feet North thereof. [02020-4360]

 - 35 4445 North Pulaski Road (east side) from a point lying 125 feet south of West Sunnyside Avenue (as measured along the east side of Pulaski Road) to a point lying 145 feet south of West Sunnyside Avenue; Reserved Parking (2 % Disabled), All Times, All Days (Public Benefit) [02020-6174]

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force here in after its passage and publication.
