ORDINANCE

FRESH FARMS INTERNATIONAL Acct. No.: 12018- 1 Permit
No: BACP1530795

Be // Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to FRESH FARMS INTERNATIONAL upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use. as now constructed, five (5) Awning with Lettering or Graphics(s) projecting over the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 2626 W DEVON AVE.

Said Awning with Lettering or Graphics(s) at N. Talman measure(s):

One (1) at twenty-two (22) feet in length and Zero (0) feet in width for a total of twenty-two (22) square feet.

Said Awning with Lettering or Graphics(s) at W. Devon & N. Talman measure(s):

One (1) at twelve point six six (12.66) feet in length and Zero (0) feet in width for a total of twelve point six six (12.66) square feet.

Said Awning with Lettering or Graphics(s) at W. Devon measure(s):

One (1) at thirty (30) feet in length and Zero (0) feet in width for a total of thirty (30) square feet. One (1) at fifteen (15) feet in length and Zero (0) feet in width for a total of fifteen (15) square feet. One (1) at thirty-three point seven five (33.75) feet in length and Zero (0) feet in width for a total of thirty-three point seven five (33.75) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Zoning Department - Signs.

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #BACP1530795 herein granted the sum of one hundred seventy-five (\$175.00) per annum in advance

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after aue date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after 04/13/2021.
